## GUIDELINES

**Media:** Any media.

**Size limitation:** There are no size limitations for this show, except entry through a standard door.

**Conditions:** You may either submit your images digitally, or drop off the actual work at LynnArts. All work must be original, ready for hanging or display and have been completed in the past 3 years. No wall anchors. Heavy work and work requiring special installation must be installed by the artist. Work previously exhibited in this gallery will not be accepted. LynnArts takes pride in your work: we will not accept broken or damaged work/frames. Entries are invited from all artists over age 17.

**Drop-off:** March 15, 10am-8pm, March 16, 10am-4pm, and March 17, 11am-4pm at 25 Exchange Street, Lynn, MA. Please fill out the following information for each piece and attach to the back of your work: number of pieces submitted, artists name, address, daytime phone number, email address, title of piece, medium and price. In addition, please fill out an Artist Inventory List, available at [www.lynnarts.org](http://www.lynnarts.org), and submit your artists resume and statement with the work.

**Digital submissions:** Images should be presented in JPEG format with image size set to 300 dpi resolution. Please include your Artist Resume and statement with your e-mail and send to [swhalter@lynnarts.org](mailto:swhalter@lynnarts.org). Type Mi Casa Es Tu Casa in the subject line. Accepted work must be delivered March 24, 11am-4pm.

**Notification:** All artists will be notified by e-mail if your work is accepted. If you do not have an e-mail address, please call LynnArts between 1 and 5 pm on Monday March 26.

**Work not accepted:** Must be picked up March 24, 11am-4pm.

**Accepted work:** Unsold work may be picked up May 3, 4, 5 during regular gallery hours.

**Commission:** LynnArts, Inc. retains a 25% commission on all work sold during the show.

**Liability:** Artwork will be insured upon arrival at LynnArts. We reserve the right not to insure works that are damaged or structurally unsound. Works left at LynnArts beyond the stated pick-up date are not insured and will be charged a \$5 per day/per piece fee.

**The Juror:** Jesse Thompson currently lives and works in Providence, RI, where he made his home after receiving his Masters in Fine Arts from the Rhode Island School of Design. In his spare time he makes art, reads comic books like it is his job and eagerly shakes the hand of any stray cat he meets. He currently teaches at Montserrat College of Art.

LynnArts, Inc. is a private non-profit arts organization located in Lynn's Central Square at 25 Exchange Street. The building houses two large and airy gallery spaces as well as a black-box rehearsal/performance space and several artist studios.
