## GUIDELINES

**Media:** All works must be made of or on paper.

**Size limitation:** there are no size limitations for this show, except entry through a standard door.

**Conditions:** You may either submit your images digitally, or drop off the actual work at LynnArts. All work must be original, ready for hanging or display and have been completed in the past 3 years. No wall anchors. Heavy work and work requiring special installation must be installed by the artist. Work previously exhibited in this gallery will not be accepted. LynnArts takes pride in your work: we will not accept broken or damaged work/frames. Entries are invited from all artists over age 17.

**Drop-off:** January 19, 10am-8pm, January 20, 10am-4pm, and January 21, 11am-4pm at 25 Exchange Street, Lynn, MA. Please fill out the following information for each piece and attach to the back of your work: number of pieces submitted, artists name, address, daytime phone number, email address, title of piece, medium and price. In addition, please fill out an Artist Inventory List, available at [www.lynnarts.org](http://www.lynnarts.org), and submit your artists resume and statement with the work.

**Digital submissions:** Images should be presented in JPEG format with image size set to 300 dpi resolution. Please include your Artist Resume and statement with your e-mail and send to [swhalter@lynnarts.org](mailto:swhalter@lynnarts.org). Accepted work must be delivered January 19, 10am-8pm, January 20, 10am-4pm, and January 21, 11am-4pm.

**Notification:** All artists will be notified by e-mail if your work is accepted. If you do not have an e-mail address, please call LynnArts between 1 and 5 pm.

**Accepted work:** Unsold work may be picked up at 4pm at the Closing reception, or by special arrangement.

**Work not accepted:** Must be picked up on January 26, 10am-8pm, January 27 10am-4pm, and/or January 28, 11am-4pm during regular business hours.

**Accepted work:** Unsold work may be picked up on March 8, 9 or 10 during regular gallery hours.

**Commission:** LynnArts, Inc. retains a 25% commission on all work sold during the show.

**Liability:** Artwork will be insured upon arrival at LynnArts. We reserve the right not to insure works that are damaged or structurally unsound. Works left at LynnArts beyond the stated pick-up date are not insured and will be charged a \$5 per day/per piece fee.

**The Juror:** Ms. Thomas-Vikory received her BFA in Printmaking from Montserrat College of Art and her MFA in Printmaking and Drawing from SUNY at Buffalo. Stacy's selected juried exhibitions include 30th Anniversary Show and 25 Years, 25 Artists, Montserrat College of Art; Mondo Tera Firma and Small in a Big Big World, The Cloister Gallery, Marblehead, MA; The Landscape Reconsidered: Collage, Assemblage & Montage, the Gibbs Gallery, Arlington Center for the Arts, Arlington, MA (Fall, 2002). Her work is included in numerous private collections and in New American Paintings Catalog, February 1998. She currently teaches Book Arts, Painting and Drawing, Printmaking at Montserrat College of Art in Beverly, MA.

LynnArts, Inc. is a private non-profit arts organization located in Lynn's Central Square at 25 Exchange Street. The building houses two large and airy gallery spaces as well as a black-box rehearsal/performance space and several artist studios.
